

Application Process

The Explore Program at the Upper Valley Career Center is a unique opportunity designed to help students experience different careers through the career technical programs offered through the school.

The Goal: To help facilitate each student's ability to secure employment that suits them.

Career exposure is facilitated through rotations where data is collected to show the interest and ability levels of each student. Participants, parents, and the IEP team will assess the student's best path to achieve their goals upon completion of the program. Continued career pathways may include entry into a career-technical program offered at Upper Valley Career Center, the Launch program, or direct and supported job placement

PROGRAM FACTS

- The student must be at least a high school junior grade level.
- The student must be at least 16 years old.
- Priority will be given to students enrolled at one of our 14 associate school districts.
 - O Students applying from open enrollment schools will be placed on a waiting list until April 1, 2023.
- Students with a one-to-one aide will be placed on the waiting list until May 1, 2023.
- It must be the intention of the student and family to be working toward community employment as an adult.

TIMELINE

- Application packets accepted at the same time UVCC applications for online applications go live. All information must be completed and returned with the application.
 - O An observation and school visit will be scheduled when the completed application is received.
 - O An administrator signature from the student's home school is required before application is considered complete.
- Once a student is accepted, an IEP meeting with a UVCC representative will be held to update placement and confirm that the student goals transfer appropriately to the Explore setting.
