

Students attending Valley View High School have the opportunity to pursue and earn an Associates of Arts – Liberal Arts Degree with a combination of College Credit Plus courses offered at the high school or online and AP courses. The Associate of Arts-Liberal Arts is designed for students who are planning to transfer to a four-year college or university in a variety of majors. Transferring students can select specific electives based on the requirements of their intended major at the receiving institution. Credit earned through AP require AP scores to be sent to Sinclair. Students must score a 3 certainty of the AP Scores to be sent to Sinclair.


