What is Career Navigation?

We are providing 1:1 student strategic career exploration. A career navigator will walk through a high school career exploration plan by understanding a student's skills, interests, and values. Exploring different career and coursework options will allow a student to make more informed decisions about what opportunities will be available after graduation.

WHAT IS YOUSCIENCE?

YouScience is an aptitude based assessment that provides a glmpse at career clusters and pathways based upon understanding skills, interests, and values. The 90 minute "brain games" assessment is a springboard to exploring substantiated opportunities and planning a course of action to achieve a student's career goals.

BUSINESS PARTNERSHIPS

For this plan of action to work for our region, building business partnerships and a vast understanding of the pain points in hiring our current workforce is key to bridging the gap. We understand the value of creating a one-stop community link to grow career programming and education
